



Privacy Policy for the Usage of Nomen™

1 Introduction

Nomen is an application for the correct pronunciation of Names. In a more and more globalized world, every day we are confronted with people from different countries, using different languages and even different alphabets.

Every user can contribute by recording first names in their native language and alphabet, therefore creating a global database that helps you and others pronounce names properly.

It is available for Android, iOS and browsers.

Respect for your privacy is paramount for us! Our Privacy Policy helps explain our information practices and applies to all of our Apps, services, features, software, and website (together, “Services”) unless specified otherwise.

Please also read “Terms and Conditions for the Usage of Nomen” (Ts&Cs), which describes the terms under which you use our Services.

2 Information we collect

Nomen receives or collects information when we operate and provide our Services, including when you install, access, or use our Services.

2.1 Information you provide

You provide personal data to create a Nomen account.

We do retain your recordings in the ordinary course of providing our Services to you and others. Once your recordings are uploaded, they are kept on our servers/the cloud. The recordings are not encrypted and will be kept or deleted at our discretion.

If you subscribe and do a personal recording (with a connected QR code), it is accessible to everyone. When you cancel your subscription, this recording will become unavailable to all users and will be subsequently erased.

2.2 Automatically collected Information

We collect service-related, diagnostic, and performance information. This includes information about your activity, log files and diagnostic, crash, website, performance logs and reports.

If you pay for our Services, we may receive information and confirmations, such as payment receipts, including from App stores or other third parties processing your payment.

We collect device-specific information when you install, access, or use our Services. This includes information such as hardware model, operating system information, browser information, IP address, mobile network information, location information and device identifiers.

We use cookies to operate and provide our Services, including to provide our Services that are web-based, improve your experiences, understand how our Services are being used, and customize our Services. For example, we use cookies to provide Nomen for web and desktop and other web-based services. We may use cookies to remember your choices, such as your language preferences, and otherwise to customize our Services for you.

2.3 Third-Party Information

We work with third-party providers to help us operate, provide, improve, understand, customize, support and market our Services. We work with companies to distribute our apps, provide our infrastructure, delivery and other systems, supply map and places information, process payments, help us understand how people use our Services and market our Services. These providers may provide us information about you in certain circumstances.

We allow you to use our Services in connection with third-party services. If you use our Services with such third-party services, we may receive information about you from them. Please note that when you use third-party services, their own terms and privacy policies will govern your use of those services.

3 How We Use Information

We use all the information we have to help us operate, provide, improve, understand, customize, support and market our Services.

We operate and provide our Services, including providing customer support, and improving, fixing, and customizing our Services. We understand how people use our Services and analyse and use the information we have to evaluate and improve our Services, research, develop, and test new services and features and conduct troubleshooting activities. We also use your information to respond to you when you contact us. We use cookies to operate, provide, improve, understand and customize our Services.

We verify accounts and activity and promote safety and security on and off our Services, such as by investigating suspicious activity or violations of our Terms, and to ensure our Services are being used legally.

We communicate with you about our Services and features and let you know about our terms and policies and other important updates. We may provide you marketing for our Services.

You share your information as you use our Services and we share your information to help us operate, provide, improve, understand, customize, support and market our Services.

4 Third-Party Providers

We work with third-party providers to help us operate, provide, improve, understand, customize, support and market our Services. When we share information with third-party providers, we require them to use your information in accordance with our instructions and terms or with express permission from you.

When you use third-party services that are integrated with our Services, they may receive information about what you share with them. If you interact with a third-party service linked through our Services, you may be providing information directly to such third party. Please note that when you use third-party services, their own terms and privacy policies will govern your use of those services.

5 Deleting your Nomen Account

You may delete your Nomen account at any time (including if you want to revoke your consent to our use of your information). Please remember that when you delete your account, it does not affect the common recordings you did.

Your personal recording will become inaccessible with the cancelation of your subscription.

6 Assignment, change of Control and Transfer

All of our rights and obligations under our Privacy Policy are freely assignable by us to any of our affiliates, in connection with a merger, acquisition, restructuring, or sale of assets, or by operation of law or otherwise, and we may transfer your information to any of our affiliates, successor entities or new owner.

7 Law and Protection

We may collect, use, preserve, and share your information if we have a good-faith belief that it is reasonably necessary to:

7.1 respond pursuant to applicable law or regulations, to legal process, or to government requests;

7.2 enforce our Terms and any other applicable terms and policies, including for investigations of potential violations;

7.3 detect, investigate, prevent, and address fraud and other illegal activity, security or technical issues; or

7.4 protect the rights, property, and safety of our users, Nomen or others.
